

**Coaching Education USATF Level I
USA Track and Field South Carolina
Scholarship Application**

USA Track and Field South Carolina acknowledges the need for well-educated coaches to guide athletes so they can achieve their full potential. To facilitate the goal of producing well-educated coaches, USATF South Carolina has made available 6 scholarships to pay the tuition only (\$205) to attend the USATF Coaching Education Level I School scheduled in SC for 2018 – Columbia SC at the University of South Carolina –December 14-16, 2018. South Carolina Coaches who are members of USATF SC (2018 membership required to apply) are eligible to apply for a tuition only scholarship to attend. Recipients are responsible for their own transportation, membership fees, accommodation, and meals. Candidates will be ranked based on need, coaching philosophy, and ability to contribute to an athlete’s success. The five successful recipients will be notified by e-mail by November 25, 2018. Deadline for applying is November 20, 2018. After the deadline if any of the 6 scholarships have not been awarded they will be awarded on a first come first serve basis.
