### Committee Program Activities/Events/Projects:

1. Scheduled LDR Championship Race for 2019 will be held on November 16, 2019 in Lexington, SC. The race is the Run Hard Lexington Half-marathon and the race director is Jesse Harmon and registration is on [www.lexingtonhalf.com](http://www.lexingtonhalf.com) and [www.strictlyrunning.com](http://www.strictlyrunning.com). This event also includes a 5k and 10k that are not Association Championship races.
2. Building Association level Open and Masters LDR Series expected to roll out in 2021. Will include approximately 5 - 7 key races leading up to yearly Association-level LDR Overall and Age-group Championships.

### Committee Program Goals:

The goal is to continue State Championship races and adding a State Championship series ultimately growing the open and masters membership of USATF-SC.

### Project/Program Expenses:

The USATF-SC LDR Championship will be held in conjunction with an established event. Costs to the Association will be for USATF Sanction Fees, Officials Stipends and Awards. We are using Association Championship medals/awards from the USATF-SC stock purchased in previous years and will use specific LDR SC Association Championship stickers for the backs of the medals.  
2019 Costs: Estimated \$200.00

Any races chosen for the LDR Race Series will likely be held in conjunction with an established event. Costs to the Association will be for USATF Sanction Fees, Officials Stipends and Awards. We will need to order medals and stickers for these events.  
2020/21 Costs: Estimated \$1000
